A Short Report on Agricultural Workshop under Petroleum Conservation Research Association (PCRA) held at different villages of Ranchi district.

Ten Agricultural Workshops were organised by Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda University, Ranchi at different villages of Ranchi district from 11 February 2017 to 04 March 2017 sponsored by Petroleum Conservation Research Association (PCRA) to create awareness amongst the farmers on energy and fuel conservation. During the workshop, audio visual show on fuel saving practices for operating irrigation pump set, tractors etc. were shown to the farmers through audio-visual devices. Farmers showed keen interest to watch the audio-visual programme. Formal interactions on measures to save fuel and conserve energy were undertaken in the villages. Our faculty members addressed the farmers on practices to operate agricultural implements efficiently and to save diesel and petrol/kerosene. At the end of the programme a question answer session was organised and the farmers (farm women included) actively participated in this session. Food packets were distributed among the farmers at the end of the programme.
